### Details on audio Sources:

Regardless of whether your Unite TP is configured as master or sub-master, you have the option of importing external audio signals into the group via USB-C, Bluetooth or analog.

Please note the following special aspects:

#### 1. USB-C

You can connect any computer to your Unite TP using a USB to USB C cable. Your computer will recognize the Unite TP as an audio interface for input and output. Not only can you play audio into the Unite TP, you can also output or record everything that has been routed to the TP in the group on a PC. By the way, ALL mobile Unite devices have this feature.

#### 2. Bluetooth®

Bluetooth® can be used in two different configurations. Either as a headset (talk and listen) or as a PC/Phone for inputting and outputting audio signals. Please note that you can use either Bluetooth or USB. Both are unfortunately not possible at the same time. Bluetooth® is only available on the Unite TP.

#### 3. Analog

The Unite TP has an analog AUX input via 3.5mm mini-jack. The recorded audio signal is summed to a mono signal.

#### Use the Ducker!

Ducking is a common expression in sound engineering for giving specific automatic prominence to an audio signal. This is achieved by decreasing other signals rather than increasing the user signal to be given prominence. This effect can guarantee speech intelligibility. Depending on the setting, the USB, Bluetooth or analog AUX signal is lowered or suppressed as soon as the microphone source of the Unite TP is discussed.

- DECT Connection: Broadcast**
- Uni-directional (one way)
  - One master device and unlimited receiver devices
  - One speaker, many listener
  - No backward channel



- DECT Connection: Full-Duplex**
- Bi-directional
  - Just two devices communicate (point-to-point)
  - Two devices can speak and listen simultaneously
  - Like a DECT phone: Base station and mobile device  
With Unite: Unite RP-T talkback and sub-master connections to master
