## Models: Basic and Xperience Managing the batteries



## When?

The red LED will light up to signal that the unit has less than 24h of battery left.

\*It is recommended to check all units daily and to replace their batteries if needed.



## How?

- 1. Insert a thin pin (e.g. a paper clip) in the hole on the rear panel and
- 2. Pull on the panel to unlock it.\*
- 3. Remove, recycle and replace batteries.
- 4. To close the unit, slide the panel back into place until a "click" can be heard.\*

\*Opening and closing the panel should require no major force
